MODIFICATIONS & SKIS FOR THE CESSNA 185

CONTINENTAL IO-550 ENGINE UPGRADE

One of the most effective ways of enhancing the capability and performance of your 185 is to add an IO-550 engine and Hartzell or McCauley "Power Prop." The IO-550 upgrade is rated at 300 horsepower, like the standard 520, but is rated at a higher torque. This gives you an additional 150 to 175 points of thrust for seaplanes, and a quieter ride. Unlike the 520, the IO-550 enables a maximum continuous cruising rate at 300 hp instead of just 285 hp.

- 300 hp max continuous operation
- 8-10% torque increase over the 520
- 150 RPM less than the 520 = greater longevity
- 8-10% increased cruise speed
- 8-10% shorter take-off

The Cessna 185 can be equipped with skis to keep you going all year. Our non-penetration skis offer peak performance on either snow or the runway. Compromised penetration skis result in extra drag from a wheel during a snow landing or take-off and potential damage to the ski on dry ground. Our ski operates as either a full ski OR a wheel at your discretion. Now you don't have to sacrifice performance for convenience!

- Operate as either a full ski or a wheel at your discretion
- Ski is supported by the tire during ski landing for extra stability, shock absorption and support
- Aluminum parts are anodized or epoxy primed ensuring corrosion resistance.
- High density polyethylene bottom skins deliver high performance in slush and prevent freeze down
