INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Be sure master switch of aircraft is off.
- 2. Cycle hydraulic hand pump from neutral to up to down to neutral to relieve hydraulic pressure in lines.
- 3. Remove cowling or interior panels to access hydraulic pump.
- 4. Remove hydraulic lines at pump (note which is up and down).
- 5. Remove the two existing fittings at the pump (AN815-4D).
- 6. Replace with AN804-4D fitting, AN924-4D nut, and MS28775-011 "O" ring.
- 7. Install AN924-4D nut and MS28775-011 "O" ring on fitting before installing to pump.
- 8. Tighten AN804-4D fitting so end is vertical.
- 9. Install 8A09000-048 accumulator hose to fitting and tie so hose is positioned vertical. Install AN806-4D plug to hose end.
- 10. Re-install hydraulic lines to pump up to up and down to down.
- 11. After completing above, do a gear cycle test. Check for leaks and gear operation position.
